



Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to inform you that Year 11 students will be sitting a Literature Paper 2 Mock on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> January. Students began preparation for this before the Christmas break and all remaining English lessons and home study tasks will be dedicated to further preparation.

For your information, students have been shown how to access the wealth of resources available on the English Student Drive. The guide below details the different areas that students can access to facilitate their revision over the remaining weeks.

**“Revision Resources”** is where you will find: revision tasks/checklists/guide.

**“Place for Practice”** is where you will find: comprehensive notes about each text, character, theme, context, key quotations, etc and detailed overviews of the Language questions. It is here where you can read useful information and make revision cards/notes to revise.

**“Past Papers”** is where you will find: previous year’s papers and specimen papers. It is here where you can practice your exam skills by having a go at old papers.

**“Modelled Answers”** is where you will find model example answers. Note: we will be adding to these throughout the term. It is here where you can see how other students have been successful.

**“Mark Schemes”** is where you will find the mark schemes for each of the exams. It is here where you can revise what the exam board expects of you or you can use the mark schemes to self-assess your work.

**“English Lectures”** is where you will find the PowerPoints and notes from the Tuesday Revision Lectures in the Q Theatre 3:15pm – 3:45pm. Here you will also find the timetable of what is being covered and when. It is here where you can make revision cards/notes.

Here is where you can access the Language in Literature tasks. Language style tasks (creative writing and/or transactional writing) by using the Literature texts as a springboard.

Students also have CGP revision guides, access to GCSE Pod videos and their exercise books (containing handouts, notes and essay responses) to revise from. Tuesday lectures will focus on the unseen poetry section.
